SYNOPSIS

Smetana The Bartered Bride: Dance of the Comedians

Regarded as the father of Czech music, Smetana is credited with pioneering the development of the distinctive Czech musical style. *The Bartered Bride* (1866) was a major contribution towards its international recognition. This dance at the start of Act Three is a showcase of the star performers in the travelling circus.

Don Pasquale Don Pasquale: Act Three Duet

Donizetti's masterpiece *Don Pasquale* was an immediate success in Paris in 1843. This baritone duet was added in Vienna, taken from Donizetti's then unperformed opera *L'Ange de Nisida*. Dr Malatesta finds a dismayed Don Pasquale plotting to catch his wife 'Sofronia' in an assignation and take her to the magistrate. However, Malatesta has tricked Pasquale into a sham marriage with a disguised Norina. Therefore, he dissuades him from taking such drastic action, and convinces him that they must deal with the matter themselves.

Smetana The Bartered Bride: Dance of the Comedians

Ac yntau'n cael ei ystyried yn dad i gerddoriaeth Tsiecaidd, Smetana sy'n cael y clod am danio datblygiad yr arddull gerddorol Tsiecaidd unigryw. Roedd *The Bartered Bride* (1866) yn gyfraniad pwysig tuag at gydnabyddiaeth ryngwladol i hynny. Mae'r ddawns hon ar ddechrau Act Tri yn arddangos prif berfformwyr y sycras deithiol.

Don Pasquale Don Pasquale: Act Three Duet

Bu campwaith Donizetti, *Don Pasquale*, yn llwyddiant ar unwaith ym Mharis yn 1843. Ychwanegwyd y ddeuawd fariton yn Fienna, a daw o opera Donizetti a oedd heb gael ei pherfformio ar y pryd, sef *L'Ange de Nisida*. Mae Dr Malatesta yn canfod Don Pasquale wedi'i siomi ac wrthi'n cynllwynio i ddal ei wraig 'Sofronia' mewn carwriaeth ac i fynd â hi at yr ynad. Fodd bynnag, mae Malatesta wedi twyllo Pasquale i gael priodas ffug gyda Norina sydd mewn cuddwisg. Felly, mae'n ei ddarbwyllo rhag cymryd camau mor eithafol, ac yn ei argyhoeddi bod yn rhaid iddynt ddelio â'r mater eu hunain.

Beethoven Fidelio: Act One Quartet

Fidelio is the final version of Beethoven's only opera, originally titled *Leonore*. Joseph Sonnleithner translated the work of Jean-Nicholas Bouilly, who based his French libretto on a supposedly true story. Jaquino has proposed to Marzelline, the daughter of the gaoler Rocco, but she has fallen in love with Fidelio. Unfortunately, Fidelio is in fact Leonore working incognito in the prison to free her husband Florestan. In this quartet the four characters contemplate Marzelline's love for Fidelio from their own perspectives. Marzelline is joyful; Leonore is fearful; Rocco is hopeful and Jaquino is despairing.

Handel Imeneo: Act Two Aria: Sorge nell alma mia

Handel is one of the most prolific and celebrated composers of the Baroque period. The *opera seria Imeneo* is adapted from Silvio Stampiglia's work and moralises that one must uphold duty and reason above all. Tirinto had believed his love Rosmene lost to an abduction by pirates, but she was rescued by Imeneo who then proposed to her. In this *aria di bravura*, Tirinto is devastated at the news that she will marry another and seethes with jealousy at her unfaithfulness.

Janáček The Cunning Little Vixen: Act 2, scene 4

Janáček is regarded as one of the most important Czech composers, for his innovative blending of folk music with patterns of the spoken word. Janáček adapted the libretto for *The Cunning Little Vixen* (1924) from Rudolf Těsnohládek's serialised novella and

Beethoven Fidelio: Act One Quartet

Fidelio yw'r fersiwn olaf o unig opera Beethoven, a elwid yn *Leonore* yn wreiddiol. Roedd Joseph Sonnleithner wedi cyfieithu gwaith Jean-Nicholas Bouilly, a oedd wedi seilio ei libreto Ffrangeg ar stori wir honedig. Roedd Jaquino wedi gofyn i Marzelline, merch Rocco, ceidwad y carchar, ei briodi ond mae hi wedi syrthio mewn cariad â Fidelio. Yn anffodus, Fidelio mewn gwirionedd ydy Leonore, sy'n gweithio'n gyfrinachol yn y carchar i ryddhau ei gŵr Florestan. Yn y pedwarawd hwn, mae'r pedwar cymeriad yn ystyried cariad Marzelline at Fidelio o'u safbwyntiau eu hunain. Mae Marzelline yn llawen; mae Leonore yn ofnus; mae Rocco yn obeithiol ac mae Jaquino yn anobeithio.

Handel Imeneo: Act Two Aria: Sorge nell alma mia

Handel yw un o gyfansoddwyr mwyaf toreithiog a nodedig y cyfnod Baróc. Mae'r *opera seria Imeneo* wedi'i haddasu o waith Silvio Stampiglia ac mae'n moesegu bod yn rhaid i rywun gynnal dyletswydd a rheswm yn anad dim. Roedd Tirinto wedi credu bod ei gariad Rosmene wedi cael ei herwgipio gan fôr-ladron, ond cafodd ei hachub gan Imeneo a oedd wedyn wedi gofyn iddi ei briodi. Yn yr *aria di bravura* hon, mae Tirinto yn drist iawn o glywed y newydd y bydd hi'n priodi rhywun arall ac mae wedi'i gorddi gan genfigen am iddo fod yn anffyddlon.

Janáček The Cunning Little Vixen: Act 2, scene 4

Mae Janáček yn cael ei ystyried yn un o'r cyfansoddwyr Tsiecaidd pwysicaf, am ei gyfuniad arloesol o gerddoriaeth werin â phatrymau o'r gair llafar. Addasodd Janáček y libreto ar gyfer *Y Llwynoges Fach Gyfrwys* (1924) o nofelig gyfresol Rudolf Těsnohládek ac

draws upon the Moravian traditions that appear throughout his work. The vixen, having fled the captivity of the forester and his family, meets a handsome male fox. She regales him with the tale of her escape, and in a rare moment of vulnerability, she falls in love with the other fox.

Mozart Così fan tutte: Act 1 trio

Mozart is widely praised as one of the greatest composers of the Western musical tradition and *Così fan tutte* (1790) is the last of his three great Italian operas with librettos by Lorenzo da Ponte. After its first short run, the medieval theme of fiancé-swapping was viewed as scandalous, and the opera was rarely performed until after World War II. Don Alfonso has convinced Fiordiligi and Dorabella's respective fiancés, Guglielmo and Ferrando, to pretend to leave for war to test the women's loyalty. Unaware of the plot, the sisters lament their departure and wish for gentle winds for their journey.

Britten The Rape of Lucretia: Act One Figure 42

Written for Kathleen Ferrier and first performed at the Glyndebourne Opera Festival in 1946, Britten's *The Rape of Lucretia* explores the mythohistory of the events that led to the collapse of the monarchy in Rome. Here, the Male Chorus narrates the inner thoughts of Tarquinius, the prince of Rome, as he contemplates assaulting the famously chaste noblewoman Lucretia. The Male Chorus ominously describes Tarquinius's impetuous actions as he calls for his horse and travels back to the city to find Lucretia.

mae'n defnyddio traddodiadau Morafia sy'n ymddangos drwy gydol ei waith. Ar ôl ffoi rhag caethiwed y coedwigwr a'i deulu, mae'r llwynoges yn cwrdd â llwynog hardd. Mae hi'n rhoi hanes ei dihangfa iddo, ac mewn moment brin o wendid, mae hi'n syrthio mewn cariad â'r llwynog arall.

Mozart Così fan tutte: Act 1 trio

Mae Mozart yn cael ei ganmol yn eang fel un o gyfansoddwyr gorau traddodiad cerddorol y Gorllewin, a *Così fan tutte* (1790) yw'r olaf o'i dair opera Eidalaidd wych gyda libretoau gan Lorenzo da Ponte. Ar ôl ei rhediad gyntaf fer, ystyrid bod y thema ganoloesol o gyfnewid dyweddïau yn warthus, ac yn anaml y cafodd yr opera ei pherfformio tan ar ôl yr Ail Ryfel Byd. Mae Don Alfonso wedi darbwyllo dyweddïau Fiordiligi a Dorabella, sef Guglielmo a Ferrando, i esgus eu bod yn gadael i fynd i ryfel er mwyn profi ffyddlondeb y merched. Heb wybod am y cynllwyn, mae'r chwiorydd yn galaru eu bod yn gadael ac maent yn dymuno'n dda iddynt ar eu taith.

Britten The Rape of Lucretia: Act One Figure 42

Wedi'i hysgrifennu ar gyfer Kathleen Ferrier a'i pherfformio am y tro cyntaf yng Ngŵyl Opera Glyndebourne yn 1946, mae *The Rape of Lucretia* gan Britten yn archwilio mytho-hanes y digwyddiadau a arweiniodd at fethiant y frenhiniaeth yn Rhufain. Yma, mae Corws y Dynion yn adrodd meddyliau mewnol Tarquinius, tywysog Rhufain, wrth iddo ystyried ymosod ar yr uchelwraig forwynol, Lucretia. Mae Corws y Dynion yn disgrifio gweithredoedd byrbwyll Tarquinius wrth iddo alw am ei geffyl a theithio'n ôl i'r ddinas i chwilio am Lucretia.

Bernstein Trouble in Tahiti: Scene 6

Bernstein is acclaimed as one of America's most successful musicians. He himself wrote the libretto for this one-act opera, loosely incorporating the story of his own parents' marriage. It is a day-in-the-life snapshot of the unhappy couple Dinah and Sam. I'm this scene Dinah begins to rant about the escapist twaddle she has just seen: *Trouble in Tahiti*. She is soon lost in the romanticism of the plot and its song 'Island Magic', but she abruptly snaps out of it, and embarrassedly remembers that she must return home to prepare dinner for her husband.

Mozart Die Zauberflöte: Act One Quintet

This fairytale Singspiel premiered just two months prior to Mozart's death in 1791. Emanuel Schikaneder drew from several sources for the libretto, including popular Viennese theatre traditions and Freemasonry. The three ladies, the attendants of the Queen of the Night, have padlocked Papageno's mouth for telling lies, which he bemoans at the beginning of this quintet. The ladies have also asked Prince Tamino to save the queen's daughter Pamina from the evil Sarastro. They eventually remove the padlock, before preparing Papageno and Tamino for their quest to save Pamina.

Tchaikovsky Eugene Onegin: Act One Scenes 1

Tchaikovsky's enduring popularity as a composer has stemmed from his marrying of Western and Russian harmonic traditions. *Eugene Onegin* (1879) is emblematic of this style and was composed for students at Moscow Conservatory. Tchaikovsky organised the libretto from Alexander Pushkin's novel into lyrical scenes. In this first

Bernstein Trouble in Tahiti: Scene 6

Mae Bernstein yn cael ei gydnabod fel un o gerddorion mwyaf llwyddiannus America. Ef ei hun ysgrifennodd y libreto ar gyfer yr opera un-act hon, sy'n ymgorffori'n fras hanes priodas ei rieni ei hun. Dyma gip ar ddiwrnod ym mywyd y cwpl anhapus Dinah a Sam. Yn yr olygfa hon mae Dinah yn dechrau rhefr am y lol dihangol y mae newydd ei wyllo, sef *Trouble in Tahiti*. Cyn bo hir, mae hi'n cael ei cholli yn rhamantiaeth y stori a'i chn 'Island Magic', ond mae hi'n dod at ei choed yn sydyn, ac yn cofio â chywilydd bod yn rhaid iddi ddychwelyd adref i baratoi swper i'w gŵr.

Mozart Die Zauberflöte: Act One Quintet

Cafodd y stori tylwyth teg hon, Singspiel, ei pherfformio ddau fis yn unig cyn marwolaeth Mozart yn 1791. Manteisiodd Emanuel Schikaneder ar sawl ffynhonnell ar gyfer y libreto, gan gynnwys traddodiadau theatrig poblogaidd Fienna a'r Seiri Rhyddion. Mae'r tair menyw sy'n gofalu am Frenhines y Nos wedi rhoi clo ar geg Papageno am ddweud celwyddau, ac mae yntau'n cwyno am hynny ar ddechrau'r pumawd hwn. Mae'r menywod hefyd wedi gofyn i'r Tywysog Tamino achub merch y frenhines, Pamina, rhag Sarastro â'i ddrygioni. Yn y diwedd, maent yn tynnu'r clo, cyn paratoi Papageno a Tamino ar gyfer eu hymdrech i achub Pamina.

Tchaikovsky Eugene Onegin: Act One Scenes 1

Mae poblogrwydd parhaus Tchaikovsky fel cyfansoddwr wedi deillio o'r ffaith iddo baru traddodiadau harmonig y Gorllewin a Rwsia. Mae *Eugene Onegin* (1879) yn symbol o'r arddull hwn, chafodd ei chyfansoddi ar gyfer myfyrwyr yn y Conservatoire ym Moscow. Rhoddodd Tchaikovsky drefn ar y libreto o nofel Alexander Pushkin yn olygfeydd

scene, the chorus of peasants celebrates the harvest, and Tatyana's excitable younger sister Olga is eager to join them. Olga reprimands her sister for her melancholic disposition and delights in her own carefree confidence.

Ravel L'enfant et les sortilèges: Duo
Miaule

Ravel was hailed as France's greatest living composer in the period between the two world wars and was widely labelled as an Impressionist but was a self-described Classicist. The libretto by Colette was originally intended for a ballet but was reworked for Ravel as an operetta. Prior to this duet, the petulant child threw a tantrum and pulled the black cat's tail. The white cat interrupts the scene, and the black cat joins her in a charged duet.

Gounod Roméo and Juliette: Act 1
No.2 and No.3, and Act 2 Entracte

Gounod's *Roméo and Juliette* (1867), based on Shakespeare's play, was a major success with audiences in France and is still frequently performed across the world. The first scene takes place during a masquerade ball at the Capulet household. Mercutio, a friend to both the rival houses and Juliet's intended Count Paris, has convinced Romeo Montague to join him at the ball in disguise. When Romeo tells Mercutio of a fearful dream he had, Mercutio dismisses it as a visit from the fairy midwife of dreams Queen Mab, describing her fantastical trickeries. We then find Juliette insisting to her Nurse that she is too young to marry yet. She wants to stay in the sweet flame of youth for as long as possible before she must experience the winter of life's responsibilities.

Ravel L'enfant et les sortilèges: Duo
Miaule

Câi Ravel ei gydnabod yn gyfansoddwr byw mwyaf Ffrainc yn y cyfnod rhwng y ddau ryfel byd, a châl ei ystyried yn eang fel Argraffiadwr er mai Clasurydd ydoedd yn ôl ei ddisgrifiad ei hun. Roedd y libreto gan Colette wedi'i fwriadu'n wreiddiol ar gyfer bale ond cafodd ei ail-lunio ar gyfer Ravel fel operetta. Cyn y ddeuawd hon, roedd y plentyn anfoddog wedi cael stranc ac wedi tynnu cynffon y gath ddu. Mae'r gath wen yn torri ar draws yr olygfa, ac mae'r gath ddu yn ymuno â hi mewn deuawd llawn emosiwn.

Gounod Roméo and Juliette: Act 1 No.2
and No.3, and Act 2 Entracte

Bu *Roméo and Juliette* gan Gounod (1867), sy'n seiliedig ar ddrama Shakespeare, yn llwyddiant mawr gyda chynulleidfaoedd yn Ffrainc ac mae'n dal i gael ei berfformio'n aml ymhob cwr o'r byd. Mae'r olygfa gyntaf yn digwydd yn ystod dawns fygydau ar aelwyd y teulu Capulet. Mae Mercutio, sy'n ffrind i'r ddau dŷ gelyniaethus ac i'r larll Paris sy'n ddarpar ŵr i Juliet, wedi darbwyllo Romeo Montague i ymuno ag ef yn y ddawns yn gwisgo mwgwd. Pan fo Romeo yn dweud wrth Mercutio am freuddwyd frawychus a gafodd, mae Mercutio yn diystyru hynny fel ymweliad gan y Frenhines Mab, sef bydwraig hudol y tylwyth teg, yn disgrifio ei hystyrwiau rhyfeddol. Yna, gwelwn Juliette yn mynnu wrth ei Mamaeth ei bod hi'n rhy ifanc i briodi. Mae hi eisiau aros yn fflam felys ieuencid gyn hired â phosibl cyn y bydd yn rhaid iddi brofi cyfrifoldebau gaeaf bywyd.

Dove Flight: Act 3 Quartet

Flight was commissioned by Glyndebourne and premiered in 1998 where it proved to be Dove's breakthrough composition. The libretto by April de Angelis draws on the story of the Iranian refugee Mehran Karimi Nasseri, who lived trapped in the Charles de Gaulle Airport in Paris for 18 years. Tina, accompanied by the Stewardess, discovers her husband Bill in the aftermath of a torrid night with the Steward. Their evasion tactics amuse the Stewardess but only serve to enrage Tina, and once Bill admits to the affair, she is so incensed she strikes him.

Mozart Le Nozze di Figaro: Act 3 Sextet

The first of Mozart and Da Ponte's trio, *Le nozze di Figaro* (1786) is based on Pierre Beaumarchais's *Le Mariage de Figaro*. In this sextet, there has been a revelation that Figaro is the long-lost son of Marcellina and Bartolo, and a celebration ensues. Susanna misinterprets the affection between Figaro and Marcellina and is outraged, but they explain situation and she joins in their merriment. Simultaneously, the Count is livid that his plot to seduce Susanna is being foiled.

Handel Acis and Galatea: Act 1 Chorus

Considered to be the pinnacle of the pastoral opera tradition in England, Handel's *Acis and Galatea* was originally performed as a one-act masque in 1718 and adapted into a two-act work in 1739. The original libretto by John Gay references the story from Ovid's *Metamorphoses*. The nymph Galatea has fallen in love with the shepherd Acis and his friend Damon encourages the pair to pursue one another. Here, the chorus echoes their joyous duet upon meeting and falling in love.

Dove Flight: Act 3 Quartet

Comisiynwyd *Flight* gan Glyndebourne, a chafodd ei pherfformio am y tro cyntaf ym 1998 a phrofi'n gyfansoddiad llwyddiannus cyntaf i Dove. Mae'r libretto gan April de Angelis yn defnyddio stori'r ffoadur o Iran, Mehran Karimi Nasseri, a fu'n byw yn gaeth ym Maes Awyr Charles de Gaulle ym Mharis am 18 mlynedd. Mae Tina, gyda'r Stiwardes, yn darganfod ei gŵr Bill yn dilyn noson nwydwyllt gyda'r Stiward. Mae eu tactegau osgoi yn diddanu'r Stiwardes ond yn cythruddo Tina, ac ar ôl i Bill gyfaddef i'r garwriaeth, mae hi wedi gwylltio gymaint fel ei bod hi'n ei daro

Mozart Le Nozze di Figaro: Act 3 Sextet

Mae'r cyntaf o driawd Mozart a Da Ponte, sef *Le nozze di Figaro* (1786) yn seiliedig ar *Le Mariage de Figaro* gan Pierre Beaumarchais. Yn y chwechawd hon, cafwyd datgeliad mai Figaro yw mab coll Marcellina a Bartolo, a cheir dathliad. Mae Susanna'n camddehongli'r hoffter rhwng Figaro a Marcellina ac mae hi'n ddig, ond maent yn esbonio'r sefyllfa ac mae hi'n ymuno yn eu llawenydd. Ar yr un pryd, mae'r larll wedi gwylltio bod ei gynllwyn i hudo Susanna yn cael ei atal.

Handel Acis and Galatea: Act 1 Chorus

Ystyrir mai *Acis a Galatea* gan Handel yw uchafbwynt y traddodiad opera bugeiliol yn Lloegr, a chafodd ei pherfformio'n wreiddiol fel masque un-act yn 1718 a'i haddasu'n waith dwy-act yn 1739. Mae'r libreto gwreiddiol gan John Gay yn cyfeirio at y stori o *Metamorphoses* Ovid. Mae'r nymff Galatea wedi syrthio mewn cariad â'r bugail Acis ac mae ei ffrind Damon yn annog y pâr i ganlyn ei gilydd. Yma, mae'r corws yn adleisio eu deuawd llawen ar ôl cyfarfod a syrthio mewn cariad.
